All abstracts are evaluated on the basis of quality, originality and topicality by the Conference Committee through a fair and rigorous procedure in order to guarantee a technical program of outstanding quality.

After acceptance of the abstract, authors will be requested to submit the full paper and a power-point presentation.

Papers should avoid the use of brand names as much as practical and refrain from specific product endorsements.

Presentations are generally 30 minutes long with AV component to engage the audience. There will also be time allowed for Q&A.

All accepted papers must be presented at the conference by one of the named authors.
